Minutes from St. Peter's May Vestry May 26, 2022

Kelly began the meeting at 4:31 PM, which Bishop Logue offering the opening prayer.

A consensus agenda was put forward by Kelly. A motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Peter Kastner and seconded by Kathy Field. The vote to approve the consent agenda was unanimous.

Bishop Logue led a conversation about St. Peter's health at this stage in the pandemic and after a year of transition, contextualizing St. Peter's among other parishes in the diocese, and contextualizing the Diocese of Georgia in comparison to other dioceses of the Episcopal Church. Together the vestry and bishop celebrated successes of the past year and looked ahead to the specific strategic plan goals relating to children's ministry and eldercare.

The vestry then transitioned to an activity called the Shape of the Parish. Kelly and Bishop Logue introduced the model and then all paused to share dinner in small groups. After dinner, the vestry returned to the Shape of the Parish exercise, specifically considering how what St. Peter's does programmatically maps onto the various categories of parish involvement.
